WELCOME

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell!

WORSHIP

Please set up 1 praise song and 1 worship song. End Worship in prayer.

WORD

Start by asking members who would like to share, what stood out for them from this week Sunday's sermon?

Ask a homecell member to read: Galatians 5:1 NIV, Galatians 5:1 ERV

Ps Aidan Quote : One of the most prized states of being is the state of being FREE.

THE HC LEADER TO EXPLAIN: The word freedom is made up of two words, FREE and DOM. The suffix DOM, means STATE OF BEING.

Q: What does it mean to be in a "state of freedom"

A: Pastor Aidan emphasised that Freedom is the state of being free, which means we have the ability of being able to exercise your free will without restrictions !!! "You are in a permanent state of being free."

Ask a homecell member to read: Galatians 5:1 C ERV

"Don't go back into slavery again"

Q: Why do believers sometimes live like they are not free? This is very important , so spend time here !!

A: Ps Aidan looked into how we can sometimes start having conversations with ourselves about the , "I can't or I'm unable to" mindset . Don't allow anybody, any person or any situation to force you into a place where you think you can't do something."

Ps Aidan quote: The battle is often in our thinking. Isn't it amazing how we can go back into a state of being bound through our thinking and choices whilst living in a state of freedom.



Ask a homecell member to read: 2 Timothy 1:7 & John 8:35–36 NKJV

Ps Aidan Quote; You can be filled with fear while being free, but you can never be in a permanent state of fear. (so good) !!

Q: How do we fall back into slavery practically, and how do we counter it in our everyday lives?

A: We start to look for reasons why we can't, why things can't workout , or thinking thoughts like God has maybe changed his mind about me. We look for all these reasons, that's going to put you back in that state of slavery. Countering this is going to take EFFORT to take thoughts captive and STAND in our freedom and victorious mindset.

Ask a Homecell member to read: 2 Corinthians 4:13, Acts 16:22-24, Acts 16:25-26, Psalm 105:1-2 NKJV

Q: What is powerful about our words?

A: Our words reflect our heart. Ps Aidan said that The word of God is not chained. Why? The word of God is in your heart and in your mouth. We also believe therefore we speak!!

Homecell leader reflection NB.

Ps Aidan showed us from scripture that Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and everyone's chains became loose. A powerful takeaway from this was that your faith doesn't just free you, it impacts others.

Q: Who is “listening” to your life? Why is it important to note that people are listening to our lives? What are they hearing from your life?

Acts 16:25C NKJV “The other prisoners were listening to them”

A: We can so easily become so fixated on our own lives and challenges that we don't always realise how that can influence someone else's life. Many people in our immediate life can be reached and influenced if we remain aware that people are listening to our lives. Someone else can stay in slavery because we are still bound. Living with a positive, contributing mindset can free someone else from their chains. That's the core responsibility we have as believers.

ASK THE CELL AS CLOSING QUESTIONS: DONT SKIP :)

WHEN WAS THE LAST TIME THEY INVITED SOMEONE TO CHURCH TO EXPERIENCE THIS FREEDOM WITH THEM?

ARE THE PEOPLE IN OUR LIVES MORE COMMITTED AND INVOLVED IN A RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD IF THEY LISTEN TO YOUR LIFE?



CALL TO ACTION:

BREAK UP INTO GROUPS AND PRAY FOR ONE ANOTHER, AREAS THAT MIGHT BE FILLED WITH FEAR. THEN PRAY FOR THOSE WHO ARE LISTENING TO OUR LIVES. IDENTIFY THEM AND LETS TRUST TO SEE THEM AT CHURCH ON SUNDAY!!
